Biographical Statement for Dr. Christina Weiland, Ed.D.



Christina Weiland is Professor at the Marsal Family School of Education and the Karl and Martha Kohn Professor of Social Policy at the Ford School of Public Policy at the University of Michigan. Her research focuses on the effects of early childhood interventions and public policies on children's development, especially on children from families with low incomes. Her work is also characterized by strong, long-standing research collaborations with practitioners, particularly the Boston Public Schools Department of Early Childhood. She holds a doctorate in Quantitative Policy Analysis in Education from the Harvard Graduate School of Education.
